EAST PETERSBURG PAST

1834

The enactment of the Public School Law was passed by East Petersburg, replacing the popular local German language with the more popular English language in the school system.

1847

The Lutherans and the German Reformed members built a large brick meetinghouse in the northwestern part of town as a cooperative venture. They shared the meetinghouse by worshippers on alternate Sabbaths.

1857

Tobias Miller opened a clothing & tailoring establishment in town.

COOKING UP THE PAST

PUMPKIN PECAN (PEEKIN') PIE

From the colonial kitchen of Mount Vernon

Ingredients:

- 4 eggs, slightly beaten
- cups canned or mashed cooked pumpkin
- 1 cup sugar
- 1/2 cup dark corn syrup
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 1/2 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1 unbaked 9-inch pie shell
- 1 cup chopped pecans
- Combine all ingredients (except pecans).
- 2. Pour into a pie shell.
- 3. Top pie with pecans.
- 4. Bake at 350°F for 40 minutes or until set.
